MUCHO MACHO MAN broke on top and remained in a forward position throughout, patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path down the backstretch and for most of the way around the turn, ranged up to draw abreast of TRICKMEISTER coming to the five-sixteenths marker, was put to hand encouragement as he led the field into the stretch by a slim advantage, extended the margin during the ensuing furlong, held all of it and then some, crossing the finish line under a strong hand ride. HYMN BOOK broke awkwardly to the outside, with the rider momentarily taking hold, loped along at the back of the pack in the initial stages, keenly picked up interest nearing the end of the backstretch, reaching the penultimate member by the three-eighths pole, spun four wide into the stretch under a strong drive, got straightened away and maintained the momentum, finished willingly to procure the place while never posing a serious danger to the top one. TRICKMEISTER off to an alert beginning, worked his way to secure the front while making his way down the chute and tucked along the rail, was coaxed along setting the splits while under the watchful eye of the top one, continued along on the same scenario until leaving the three-eighths pole, had the winner draw alongside late on the turn and increase the pressure, was let out soon in response, surrendered just prior to reaching the head of the stretch, weakened steadily down the lane. TO HONOR AND SERVE parked in the three path within range, came up empty when asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole. STAY THIRSTY appeared to lose his footing at the break, settled into midpack, departed the backstretch three wide, was asked for run, feeling the whip a couple of times midway during the run around the bend, was given a few more shots spinning from the two path into the stretch, had no offering to render and folded. BUFFUM reserved from along the outside for just over three-quarters, had no impact. ENDORSEMENT came outward slightly leaving the starting gate, but was pulled away the nearest foe in time to prevent significant contact, was given some right handed stick work as early motivation, took the inside route, kept to some light urging all the while, proceeded around the turn being asked for more and more, had little left turning for home and faltered.
