Footnotes

MUCHO MACHO MAN, prompted to secure a forward placing along the inside racing into the first turn, switched out nearing the backstretch to stalk a rival under light rating, steadily moved to terms with that foe nearing the second bend, moved to command when given his cue midway through the far turn, drew well clear racing into upper stretch and extended the advantage under some mild hand urging while his rider confirmed the issue was decided when glancing at the infield display. JOSHUA'S COMPRISE settled into stride near the inside in the opening stages, was prompted to to gain contention racing through the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, shifted out racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to gain the place honors late while never menacing the winner. DECAF AGAIN settled in hand in last just off the inside racing to the backstretch, continued along the inside into the second bend, shifted out three wide racing into upper stretch while being prompted to advance and continued with an effort to improve position. BERNIE THE MAESTRO was urged to the lead outside the eventual winner racing into the first turn, angled to the rail once gaining the advantage, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the second bend but quickly emptied out once headed by the winner. GOURMET DINNER was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. RULE NUMBER SIX bobbled at the start, was quickly righted to gain a contending position tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing three deep to the backstretch but steadily retreated racing into the second bend.
