Footnotes

RON THE GREEK angled over to the rail saving ground going into the first turn, pulled slightly in opening stages, settled in and stalked the early pace, given his cue to pick up the pace near the three eighths pole, quickly gained ground between rivals, rushed up to take the lead, continued to widen margin in the upper stretch and drew off unchallenged in the late drive. CASH RULES was carried out wide by rival going into the first turn, settled in and stalked the pace in opening stages, continued patiently leaving the backstretch, urged to pick up the pace, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane and steadily gained ground to capture place position in the stretch. FORT LOUDON was carried out five to six wide heading into the first turn, pulled in opening stages and edged up to the lead, vied along the inside of I'M STEPPIN' IT UP in the early going, shook free from rival leaving the backstretch, was passed by RON THE GREEK in the final turn, continued along the rail in the lane and lacked late kick. ATONED was reserved in early stages and settled in stalking the early pace, continued patiently leaving the backstretch, floated out five wide into the far turn and slightly gained position in the stretch. DECAF AGAIN lacked speed in opening stages and raced in the back of the pack, continued to race evenly heading into the far turn and passed a couple tiring rivals in the drive. I'M STEPPIN' IT UP broke sharp and took the lead, drifted out slightly and carried out rivals in the first turn, began to vie for the lead along the inside in the backstretch and could not keep up the pace entering the final turn. MUCHO MACHO MAN broke sharp, was carried out wide into the first turn, angled out slightly and edged up to the lead, gave way heading into the far turn and was pulled up in the stretch.
